Fun Summer Activities

- **Plant a veggie garden.**

Detailed Steps:

Seed Collection or Purchase* : If growing from store-bought fruit, carefully extract the seeds from the pulp, wash them to remove the gelatinous material, and let them dry.

Seed Starting : Fill seed-starting trays or individual pots with a pre-moistened seed-starting mix. Sow the seeds about 1/4 inch deep, spacing them out (e.g., 3 seeds per cell) as not all seeds may germinate.

Warm and Sunny Environment: Place the trays or pots in a warm, sunny area.

Watering : Keep the soil consistently moist, but not waterlogged.

Thinning Seedlings : Once the seedlings are a few inches tall and have one to two sets of true leaves, thin them out so that each seedling has its own pot or cell.

Planting : Choose a sunny location with well-draining soil.

Watering and Fertilizing : Water regularly, especially during dry periods.

Caring for the Plant:

- **Make a bird feeder .**

Detailed steps

- Choose the right bottle. The first step is selecting a bottle to use as the body of your bird feeder. ...
- Cut feeding holes. ...
- Add perches for the birds. ...
- Attach the string or wire for hanging. ...
- Fill with birdseed. ...
- Hang the feeder.

This is a good activity for kids to indulge in as they can learn about different birds while also helping them. You can remind the kids to put out a bowl of water too for the birds and keep refilling it.
